- Drink to Me Only With Thine Eyes (England) arr. Cumming A beloved English ballad which dates back to the beginning of the 19th century.
- Waltzing Matilda (Australia) The unofficial national anthem, this well known tune tells a tragic story of life in the outback. A swagman is a tramp carrying his swag which is his bundle wrapped up in a blanket. A billabong is a water-hole in a dried up river bed, a jumbuck is a sheep, and a squatter is a successful sheep farmer.
- Stephen Foster Jeanie With the Light Brown Hair This familiar song is typical of the 19th century parlor ballad which was the "popular" music of its day.
- Martin arr. I Think I Heard Him Say This poignant spiritual was first popularized by Harry Belafonte in the '60's.
